Biblical Order within the Church – From Moses to The Apostles

Churches have split and denominations have formed over the issue of Church government. Yet while many Christians can explain their particular church's form of rule and may staunchly uphold it, few have a truly biblical understanding of it. What model for governing the Church does the Bible provide? Is there room for different methods? Can we discover biblical order within the Church from the Apostolic Scriptures alone? As Messianic believers, is it not our responsibility to search the Torah first, as an antecedent framework for understanding what the Apostolic Scriptures teach about Church government? In this course we will reintroduce Moses and his ecclesiastical government as revealed in the Torah as the basis for the government, structure, and bylaws of The Harvest. Our form of congregational government arises from the Mosaic/Torah model rather than an anti-Judaic and anti-Torah model. Most Pastors and Elders neglect what the Torah reveals about Church order and government and thus create structures and bylaws, which are easy targets for divisive and destructive Korah and Jezebel agendas. Come and learn the differences and discover what the biblical order of church government is from a Mosaic perspective. This class is required for those in the Elder Training Program.
